

Masonry Quality Institute Improves Products and Installation

The Masonry Quality Institute (MQI) is an intensive two day interactive workshop jointly developed by the Mason Contractors Association of America (MCAA) and the National Concrete Masonry Association (NCMA). In the masonry industry, MCAA represents the installers of concrete block while NCMA represents the block manufacturers. The Masonry Quality Institute brings these two groups together to educate their members about the quality improvement process. The program is designed to teach quality management to those within individual companies and to help improve quality and performance of both products and installation. It is believed that the masonry industry is the first in the construction industry to bring both installers and manufacturers of a product together to discuss potential pitfalls at each step in the construction process.
