

T-Drill – Mechanically Formed Tee Connection for Pipes and Tubes

The T-Drill mechanically forms tee connections in pipe and tube using a single brazed joint. This eliminates tee-fittings and replaces the three soft soldered joints that tee fittings require. The T-Drill is listed by I.A.P.M.O., B.O.C.A., S.B.C.C., the National Standard Plumbing Code, ANSI, and most other code regulatory bodies.

The T-Drill was invented in Finland in the late sixties. It is most often used in plumbing, HVAC, fire sprinkler, refrigeration and maintenance projects. By conservative estimate, T-Drill has been used on over 30,000 construction projects in North America, including the Library of Congress, Smithsonian Institute, and many hotels, public schools, hospitals, and correctional facilities.
